



Supporting Parishioner Policy for Discounted Tuition Rates (2024-2025 School Year)

For discounted supporting parishioner tuition rates, a supporting parishioner is defined as a registered parishioner who uses offertory envelopes in the Sunday Mass collection basket for Parish support for at least 40 out of the 52 weeks in the preceding calendar year (01/01/23-12/31/23).

A registered parishioner who does not meet the 40 out of 52 week criteria, but contributes \$300 or more in the preceding calendar year (01/01/23-12/31-23) in identifiable (labeled with name and parish ID number) parish support by envelopes or by electronic donation (Give Central), will also be considered a Supporting Parishioner.

- First year new families are given a grace year their first year at the school and to reach supporting parishioner status for the 2024-2025 year, they must be registered as parishioners with the parish office, and may either use 20 offertory envelopes in the Sunday collection basket OR donate \$150 to the church from 01/01/23-12/31/23.
- In order to meet the 40 out of 52 week envelope criteria you must:
 - Physically put your offertory envelope with your parishioner number on it in the collection basket at Sunday Mass.
 - Only one envelope a week can be given at mass. Any extra envelopes at one Mass will not count towards your 40.
- Only Sunday Church offerings will go towards your Supporting Parishioner status. 2nd collection, school donations, Baptism donations, fundraising donations are greatly appreciated, but will not be eligible towards Supporting Parishioner status.
- In summary, your calendar year 2023 (January 2023 – December 2023) church contributions will be used to qualify for your 2024-2025 supporting parishioner tuition rates.
