



Supporting Parishioner “Procedures”

A Supporting Parishioner is a registered parishioner who uses the offertory envelopes for Sunday Parish support for at least 40 out of the 52 weeks each calendar year. A registered parishioner not meeting the 40 out of 52 week criteria, but contributing \$300 or more each year in identifiable Parish support, will also be a Supporting Parishioner.

- Each family’s 2023-2024 tuition status will be based off of their 2022 Sunday envelope/*Give Central* contributions.
- First year new families will be given a grace period to reach half of the contribution requirement.
- In order to meet the 40 out of 52 week envelope criteria you must:
 - Physically give your Sunday Envelope during mass collections.
 - Only one envelope a week can be given at mass. Any extra envelopes will not count towards your 40.
- Only Sunday Church offerings will go towards your Supporting Parishioner status. 2nd collection, school donations, Baptism donations, fundraising donations are greatly appreciated, but will not be eligible towards Supporting Parishioner status.
- If you donate through *Give Central* you do not qualify to reach the 40 out of 52 weekly envelope status.
- Supporting Parishioner tuition rate will only be given to those who apply and are approved.
- Your 2022 contributions will be used to qualify for your 2023-2024 tuition rate.
